

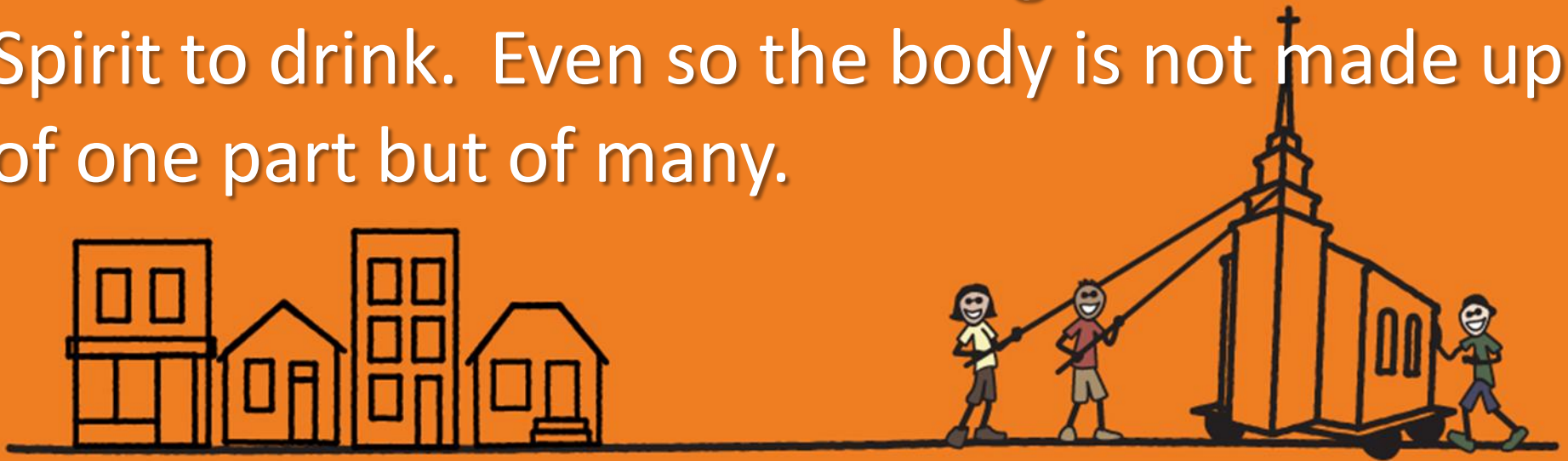
The Perfect Church

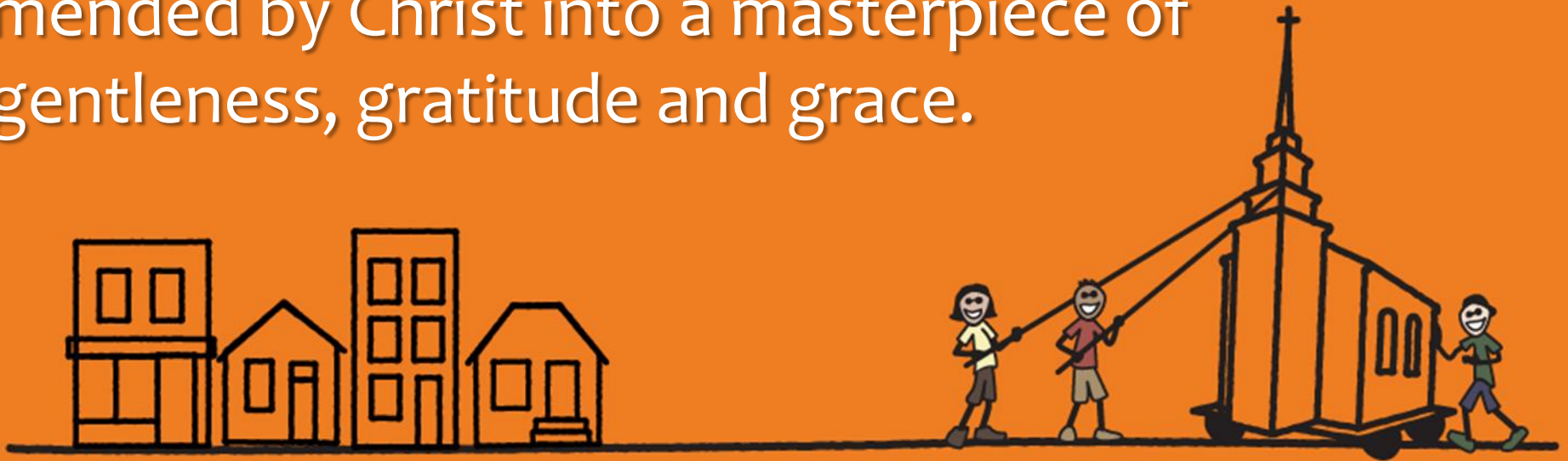


This is the Perfect Church...
